Self-penned short drama Little Boy Soldiers, launched his career, winning a Sony Award and a Royal Television Society Award.

The Gatherers, one of the world's first digital films to hit UK screens, was one of the first films to be funded by A4E Lottery Film, along with Northern Arts Production Fund, Border TV and Sony Pro UK who took the film on UK tour of screenings, climaxing at The 1999 Edinburgh Film Festival. The Gatherers was digitally remastered for 20th anniversary screenings in 2018.

At the turn of the millennium lan held a unique position in British theatre: Film Maker In Residence at Northern Stage under renowned artistic director Alan Lyddiard. Ian's *Screenlab* community film project brought filmmaking to many vulnerable communities.

As a commissioned screenwriter, Ian has worked on projects with Robson Green's Coastal Productions and with Keith and Dawn Thompson at Diplomat Films and worked as commissioned screenwriter on rom-com movie *Heirs & Graces* with producer Danny Midwinter, currently in prep with esteemed actor-director David Hayman.

lan directed second unit on Warner Bros hi-action feature film, Centurion - Director Neil Marshall (Dog Soldiers, The Descent, Game Of Thrones). Producers: Christian Coulson (Slumdog Millionaire) and Richard Jones (Usual Suspects).

As a digital innovator, lan directed groundbreaking, transmedia teen drama series' *The Morning After The Night Before* and *Freshers* for E4 / Conker Media / Lime Pictures; winning a Clarion Award. The same team consolidated these successes with *Hollyoaks DocYou* for Channel 4, which won an RTS Award for "Innovation in Cross Platform". As world leaders in transmedia content creation, lan and producer Chris Wood created a range of interactive online features, for Disney's *Evermoor Confidential Chronicles*. Ian further consolidated his online content creation expertise with a 2017 RTS Award for Best Online Production for safe teen-driver social media campaign *#FriendsDriveSafe*.

Continuing his industry practice whilst committed to his role as an educator, Ian, is currently engaged as co-creator in development of TV family-sports drama serial *The Academy* and is making a return to short film with a moving new screenplay *Mr Apple,.* Working alongside Executive Producer Peter Hoar to fast track develop new, upcoming young talent such as award winning producer Tyla Sharp.

As a published songwriter and recording artist lan continues to create, perform, record and release new songs as *The Cottontown Sound Corporation* on his own record label as well as creating and managing music soundtrack services.
